Father Elmer W. Heindl, Seneca-Cayuga coordinator, said, "Bishop Matthew H. Clark has asked each region to arrange a sharing time to celebrate the Eucharist, homilize and dialogue with regional personal persons in leadership roles and concerned positions at 'town ball' type meetings."

The bishop will celebrate a Mass at 7 p.m. with the theme to be Vatican II's Decree on the Apostolate of Lay People, according to Father Heindl.

All persons from the region are invited to the Mass.

From 8 to 10 p.m. in Holy Family Hall, the bishop will welcome comments, questions and observations, informally presented "in Christian charity and mutual love and concern," according to an announcement of the meeting. Anyone presenting their names to the coordinator before the Mass will be given priority in the order their names are presented. After these, the floor will be open for questions.

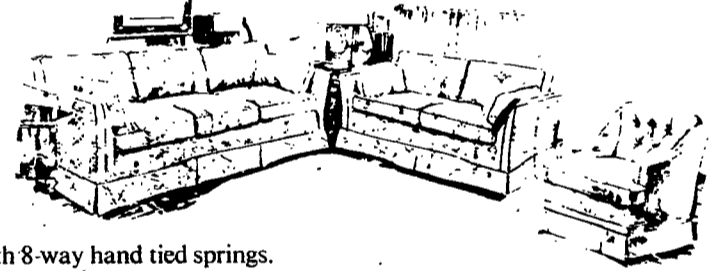


CDA Installed
