Christ the King Dedicated Anew

An assembly which filled Christ the King Church to standing room only greeted Bishop Matthew H. Clark on the Feast of Christ the King, last Sunday.

Bishop Clark was leading the rededication of the edifice on Kings Highway. According to a parish spokesman the church was originally to have been an interim structure when it was first blessed 22 years ago.

A decision was recently made, he said, to renovate the building and dedicate it

as the community's permanent house of worship.

The renovation includes a "completely new sanctuary, new stained glass windows and carpeting throughout," among other features, the spokesman said.

Father Thomas Mailloux, CSB, pastor, greeted Bishop Clark, observing that they had met in Rome six months, almost to the day, earlier.

The dedication rites concluded with a reception for Bishop Clark in the parish hall.
