People often ask us about the poor we serve at Saint Monica's School. How badly do they need help? What kinds of problems have made the lives of these people so hard? Why is Catholic education so important to the poor? Here are a few of the people we serve.

Mrs. K is a deeply committed Christian. a very warm and loving mother of four children. She is medically unable to work, and has been in and out of the hospital many times for an a muscular illness in her legs. The family has an income of pless than \$6.000 a year. income offess than \$6,000 a year.

Mr. C. was seriously injured in an accident last year, and was partially disabled for almost a year. Mr. C., his wife, and their two children live in a modest 19th Ward home and supported the family on less than \$5.000 last year. Mr. C.'s accident created thousands of dollars in medical bills not

covered by insurance. He has no idea how these will be paid
"Mrs. J's husband left her many years ago. She has three children ages 5. 8.
and 10. and supports them with about \$6.000 a year, received from the

and 10, and supports them with about \$5.000 a year, received from the Department of Social Services. Her social worker reported that she was having such difficulty with the support of her family that she was on the verge of an emotional breakdown a year ago.

*Mrs. S. is an older woman, legally responsible for her 8 year old grandson. She has had several heart attacks, continuing high blood pressure, and her doctor has advised her to discontinue her work as a maid and homemaker Last year, she made about \$2.300, working part time. And received another

\$2.500 from social security and disability payments. She will do anything to make Catholic education possible for her grandson. TMrs. D. has two children, ages 4 and 8. Her former husband, an alcoholic, refuses to provide family support. Mrs. D. lives in a small west side apartment. and struggles to make ends meet with the income from two part time jobs. Last year, her income was slightly over \$4.000

These are all real people, and every one of these stories is true. The heartbreaking part of this message is that these stories could go on and on. There are dozens more and sad cases like these.
