St. Ambrose, Rochester

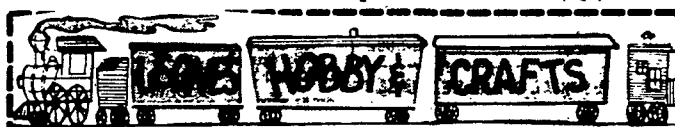
Boy Scout Troop 231 from St. Ambrose parish will sponsor a Pancake Breakfast on Sunday, Dec. 16 after the 8
