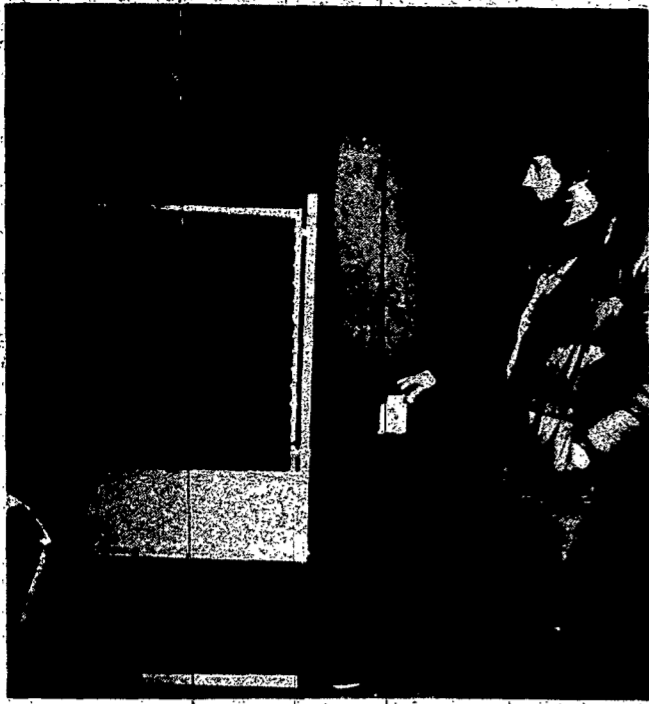


At Your Parish ... St. Charles, Greece
