

NY Priest Is Named Mission Head

New York (RNS) — Msgr. William J. McCormack, vice-chancellor of the New York Catholic Archdiocese, has been named national director of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith.

He succeeds Archbishop Edward T. O'Meara who had held the post since 1964 when he succeeded Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen. Archbishop O'Meara was named to head the Archdiocese of Indianapolis last November.

Msgr. McCormack, 56, was director of the Propagation of the Faith in the New York Archdiocese from 1964 to 1970. He has also served as a member of the national board of the society. In 1970 he was named vice-chancellor of the

archdiocese and chairman of its building committee, director of Institutional Commodities Services (a buying service), and director of Ecclesiastical Maintenance Services.

A native New Yorker, the prelate was graduated from Williams College and served in the U.S. Coast Guard in World War II. He was working as an executive for a petroleum transportation firm in New York when he decided to enter the seminary, and was ordained at the age of 35 in 1959.

Since 1970, Msgr. McCormack has also served as archdiocesan director of the Catholic Overseas Aid Appeal and the Catholic Relief

Services' Thanksgiving Clothing Appeal. In 1968 he was appointed director of the Archdiocesan Office of World Justice and Peace.

The Society for the Propagation of the Faith in this country is part of a global mission society of the Catholic Church, which supports missionary activity in 800 dioceses throughout the world. Most of these are in Asia and Africa.

Appointment of Msgr. McCormack was made by Pope John Paul II and announced in Washington by Archbishop Jean Jadot, the apostolic delegate.
