Bishop Matthew Clark joined diocesan elementary school principals for their Day of Recollection out at the Sisters Of St. Joseph Mother House, March 21. In keeping with the day's purpose of prayer and meditation, the Bishop's talk encompassed the Lenten season, Holy Scripture, and individual commitment to Christ.

He recognized the frustrations the educators face at times, but he challenged them to study well the deeper treasures of the faith and their own commitment to prayer. "I feel it important to be persons of prayer," he said and in referring to the various life vocations emphasized, "We can't talk about any ministry unless it is rooted in prayer."

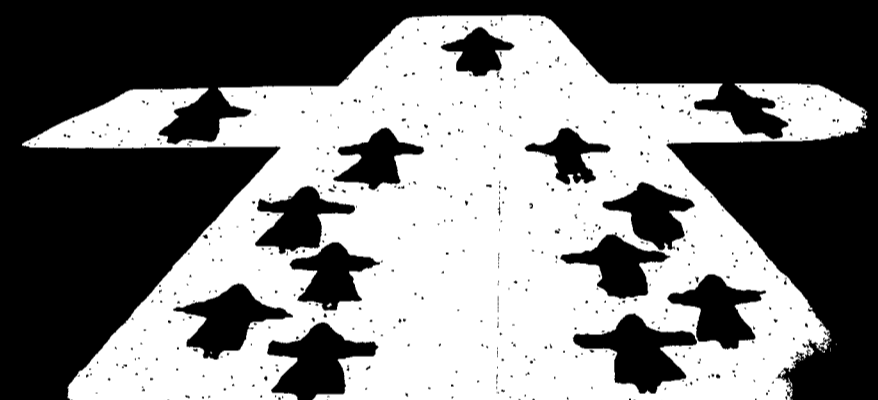
