### Seminar to Focus On Adult Baptism

Among the subjects under study by the Program Planning project of the Office of Religious Education is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). Parish staffs are beginning to consider the catechumenal process for initiating new members into the Christian community and to reflect on its implications, not only in the life of the catechumen, but also on the parish as a whole. Several parishes have already introduced the catechumenate in some or all of its stages.
