

# Workshop Held Here For Asian Refugees

More than 150 Southeast Asian refugees and their sponsors crowded into workshops on teaching English as a second language and refugees' employment opportunities last week. The occasion was the first Co-Workshop for Indochinese Refugees and Their Sponsors, presented by the Refugee Resettlement Staff at Catholic Family Center.

According to Barbara Letvin of the CFC, the response to the workshops cut across denominational lines and included both family and institutional sponsors.

And Ann Humaydan, also of the CFC, said that the turnout for the program was so great that plans are already in the works for another in September.

The language workshop speakers included Eileen Spillane and Don Beech from the Indochinese Refugee Assistance Project; Rosemarie Toscano, associate educational specialist for the National Technical Institute for the Deaf; and Patrice Lancelot, advisory specialist for the Rochester City School District.

The employment workshop featured speeches by Ms. Barbara Barton, an interviewer for the New York State Employment Service; and Mark Bopp, personnel representative at Taylor Instrument. Interpreting the
