### 16 Priests, Nuns Freed by Bolivia

St. Louis (RNS) — Sixteen Catholic priests and nuns, including Msgr. David Ratermann, a St. Louis missionary, were released together by Bolivia's new government in La Paz Aug. 5.

since a military junta took power in Bolivian shortly before a democratically elected civilian government was to be sworn in.

Rapisarda, the Vatican's diplomatic representative in Bolivia, gave asylum to Lydia Quiler Tejada, the ousted interim president of the country, and protested the clergy arrest.
