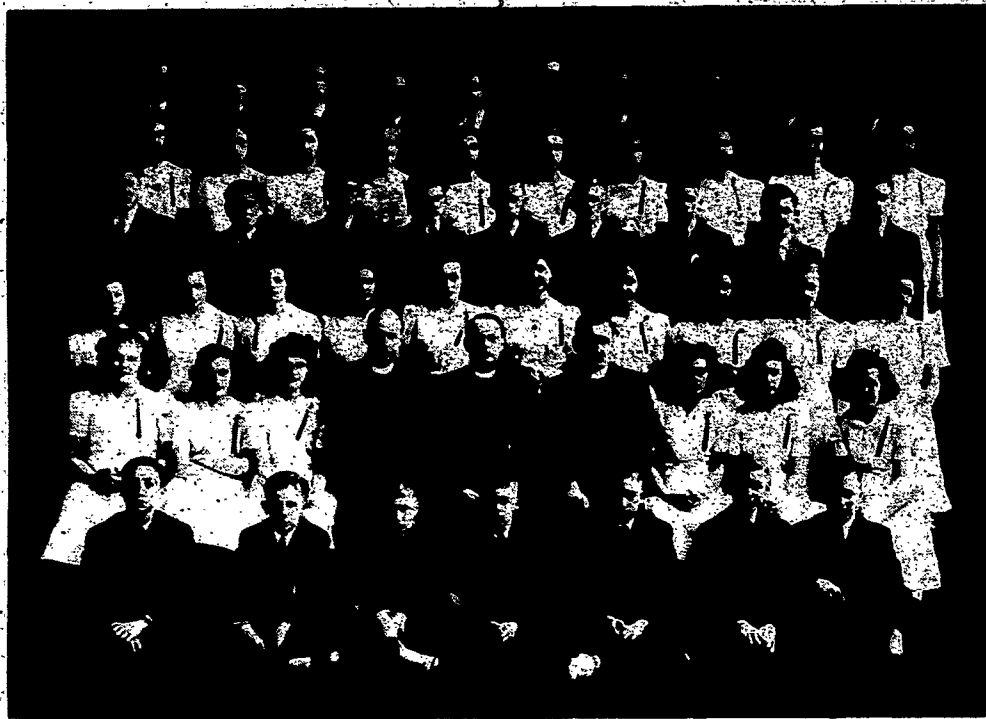

Corpus Christi, Rochester
