

Bishop to Celebrate Wedding Jubilee Mass

Canandaigua — Bishop Matthew H. Clark will celebrate a special Mass at St. Mary's Church for all couples in the diocese who are this year celebrating silver or golden wedding anniversaries.

The Mass has been slated for 3 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 26. A reception will follow the Mass.

The event, sponsored by the diocesan Office of Family Life, includes a renewal of wedding vows. Couples are sent an invitation from the bishop through the family life office, and receive an inscribed personal certificate.

Couples wishing to receive an invitation have been asked to contact their parish offices, who in turn forward to the family life office the names, addresses, and anniversaries celebrated.

As in the past two years, couples attending are asked to write brief reflections on the question, "How has your marriage helped you to discover the meaning of faith?"

Following are samples of the responses given last year:
