Closing Out the 80s

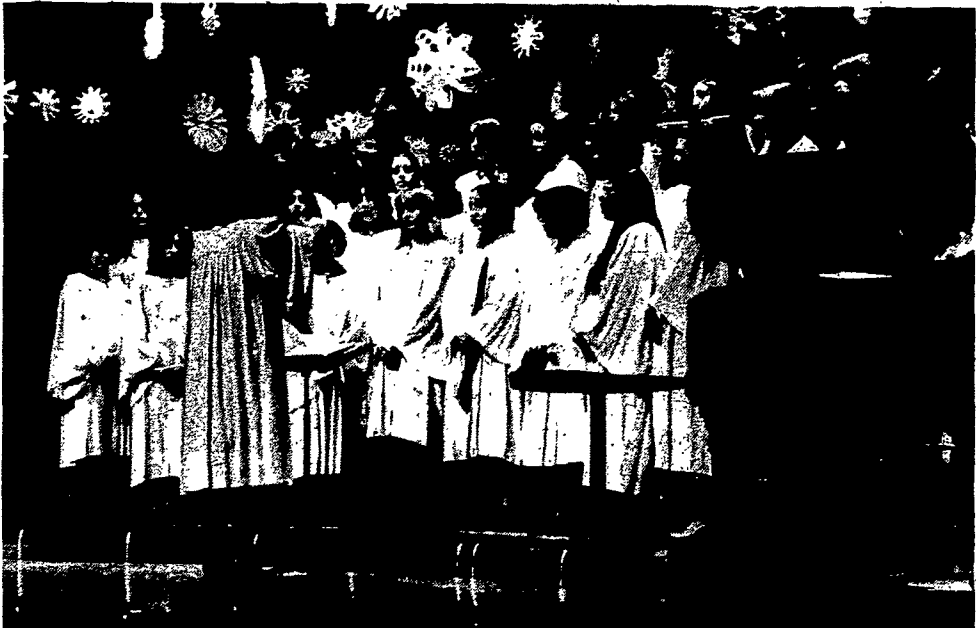
