DPC to Meet in Geneva

Geneva — The Diocesan Pastoral Council (DPC) will meet Saturday, Jan. 17, at St. Francis School, Geneva, from 8:45 a.m. to 3 p.m. The consultative body will have a variety of items on its agenda, including two proposals and a guidance letter which would influence the preparation of the diocesan budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1.

DPC members also will participate in a discussion on racism, based on the statement of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops.

The DPC's Teaching Mission Committee is bringing a proposal that a task force be set up to carry out two functions assigned to the

committee last year. The task force would design a process for training parish education committee members, and plan to initiate a diocesan Board of Education in September 1982. The Teaching Mission Committee states in its proposal that it wants a task force to complete the projects to allow it to address other educational issues.

Sister Ann Miller will present a motion concerning the handicapped. The motion follows a presentation on the handicapped given at the November meeting by Mrs. Virginia Marshall.

Jack Brophy of the Ministerial Review Committee will answer questions concerning the budget guidance letter his committee has prepared. The letter offers guidelines for preparation of the diocesan budget, and includes comments on specific diocesan programs.

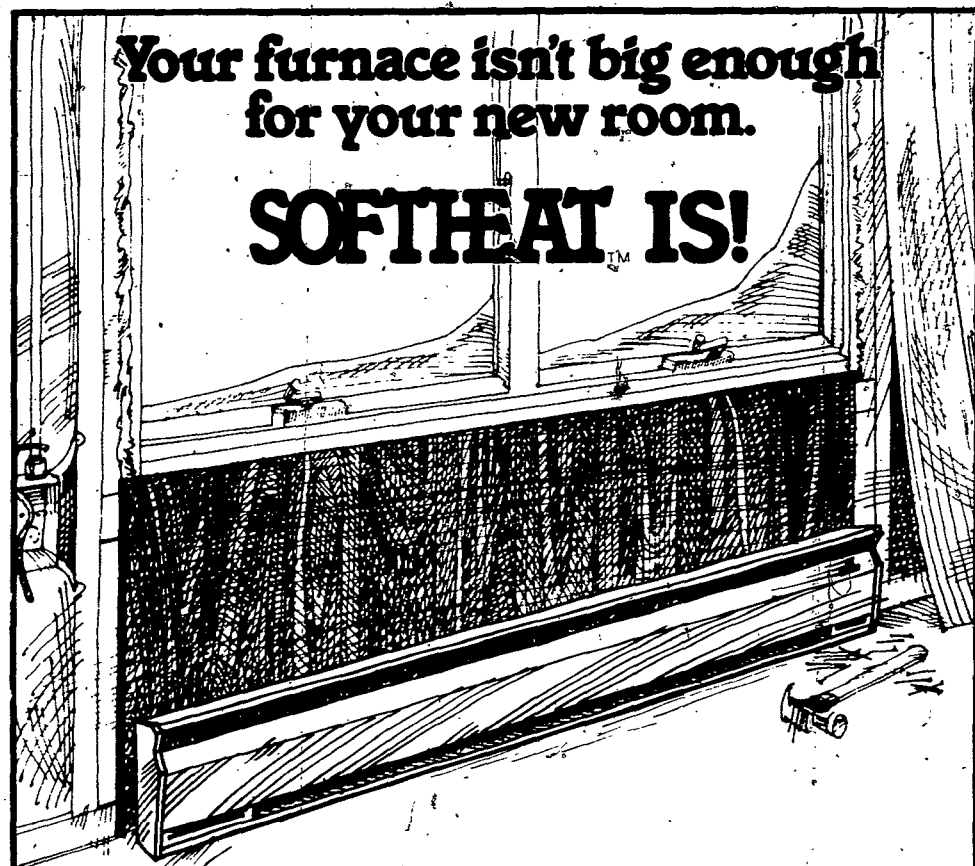
The DPC will hear a report from Sister Mary Wintish, episcopal director of Urban Ministry.
