Viewpoint: Sisters Reflect

Congregation Administration

Do you ever come up against the question, "Yes, but what do you do all day?" For me, it is easy to put words around some things — appointments, meetings, planning, decisions — but a real challenge to express those things much closer to the heart of my present ministry of congregational administration.
