Seminar to Study Budget Cut Impact

Elmira — The Southern Tier Office of Social Ministry (STOSM) is sponsoring a seminar on the impact of the proposed cuts in the federal budget at 7:30 p.m., Wednesday, April 8, in the auditorium of the Steele Memorial Library.

The seminar, designed to educate the public about the impact of the cuts and provide an opportunity for interested persons to plan future action, will open with a panel discussion and include an opportunity for participants concerned with specific aspects of the budget cuts to meet in groups.

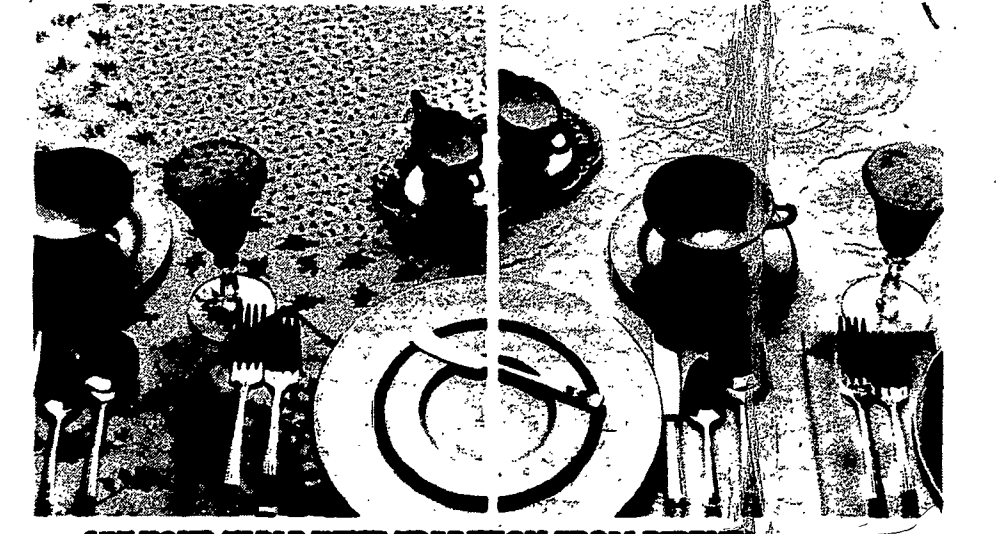
The session also will include a period for questions and comments, and a summary.

In explaining the meeting's purpose, Giovina Carosio, coordinator of the STOSM Department of Justice and Peace, cited a study done at the University of Chicago. That study concluded that a typical family on public assistance, a mother and two children, would lose 15 percent of their disposable income because of the budget cuts, while deriving no benefit from the proposed tax reductions.

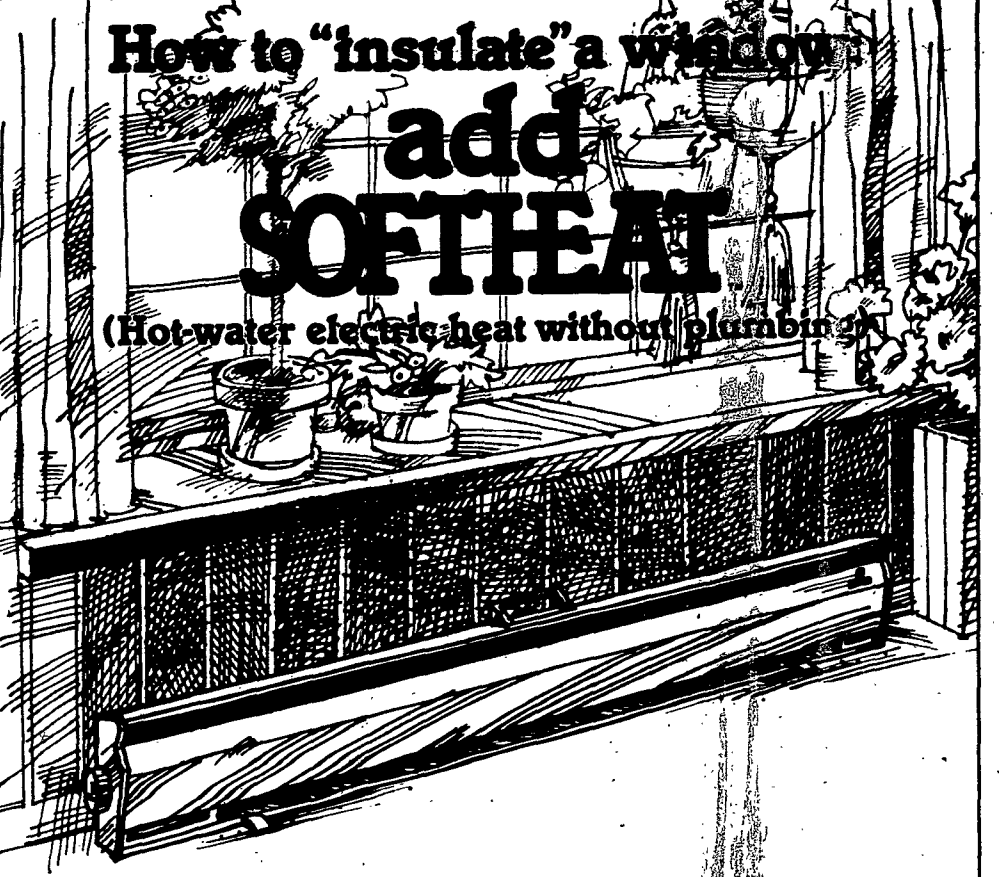
Card Tourney Begun
