

Deacon Hauser To be Ordained

Ogdensburg — Bishop Stanislaus J. Brzana will ordain Deacon Albert James Hauser, a native of Rochester, to the priesthood for the Diocese of Ogdensburg, Saturday, May 2, in St. Mary's Cathedral.

The ordinand, son of Albert and Louise McAllister Hauser, was educated at St. Peter and Paul's School and McQuaid Jesuit High School.

He received his undergraduate degree from LeMoyne College in Syracuse, and completed theological studies at Christ the King Seminary in East Aurora.

Father Hauser will celebrate a Mass in Rochester at 11 a.m. Sunday, May 3, at St. Peter and Paul's. A reception to which all former

and present parishioners have been invited is slated to follow the Mass.

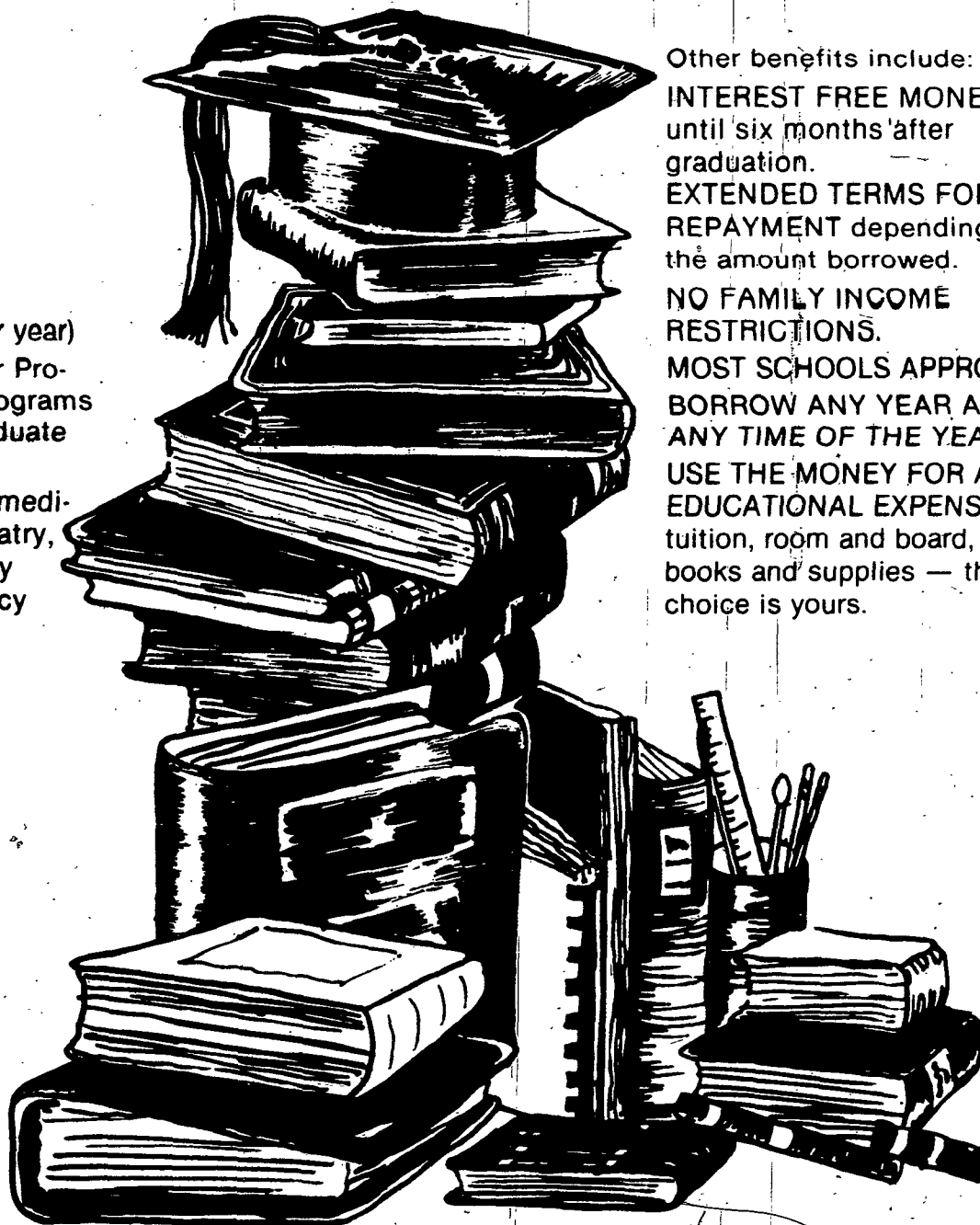
