### A Letter From the Far East

A letter arrived recently from Father Richard Kraft, SVD, from Bangued, Abra, Philippines.

"Your communications apostolate is doing great work. Thank you so much for the latest Sheen tapes. I even had a radio with a cassette player installed in the car I drive back and forth to Manila to listen to them. More time for that while driving than at home at Bangued. Incidentally I put on a Sheen tape once in place of a Conference. It was when I was acting superior and in place of a Conference the evening before our monthly meeting here in Abra, we placed the cassette recorder in the chapel and opened with a prayer. Then the Sheen conference. Everyone was quiet and attentive..."

**Comment:** Father Raymond Kraft is a 59-year-old Society of the Divine Word (SVD) missionary, the same order we have at Conesus. His father, Raymond, died at St. Ann's Home a year ago, and his mother now lives at the St. Ann's residence in Rochester, The Heritage. Mrs. Kraft is the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Frank Miller of St. Boniface in the days of Father Rauber and Msgr. Boppel, but the family moved to St. Charles, Rochester, 50 years ago, where Father Kraft attended school.

Our missionary has been in the Philippines for 25 years, and is the director of radio station DZPA, Bangued, Abra. The station was begun by the SVD

Fathers, and it broadcasts agriculture reports, local, national and international news. It gives tips on many things: health, cooking, housekeeping, jobs, and in this primitive area, notices; e.g. about when and where to pick up Juan Diego who will be dropped off from the bus at a certain crossing.

Intertwined with these notices are devotional and religious instructions, something like the Christian broadcasting stations in our country. Occasionally I send him cassettes and donations for his work. He was in Rochester four years ago, before the death of his father, and came to dinner at our Webster rectory, where he explained his radio work. I was impressed on how far-reaching his radio apostolate is, especially since his is the only radio station within a huge area. He meticulously keeps out of the political situations in the Philippines, and sticks to the religious mission of evangelization.

A few years ago he gave a radio retreat over Station DZPA for priests of the area. He used a set of Sheen retreat conferences and notified the priests when the conferences would be broadcast. The results were excellent, and several priests ordered conferences for their personal use and for their people. Is this not effective evangelization without fanfare or wasteful expense?

People have written asking if they can get the cassette of Father Richard Tormey's last two radio talks, given on the Legion of Mary program, "Magnify the Lord."
