Piffard — Brother Raymond Fournier became Father Raymond Fournier a week ago Monday when Bishop Matthew H. Clark ordained the former Trappist

Father Raymond, formerly a Christian Brother, is a native of Detroit and became a member of the Cistercian Order (Trappists) in December 1980.
