

# Sister Janice Takes Diocesan Schools Post

Sister Janice Morgan, SSJ, is the new assistant superintendent for curriculum in the diocesan Department of General Education. The position became effective July 1.

Sister Janice succeeds Sister Edwardine Weaver, RSM, the current superintendent of schools for the diocese.

Sister Janice's last appointment was as principal of St. Theodore's School, Gates, where she has been for the past eight years. Prior to that, she had taught at St. Thomas More, Immaculate Conception (Ithaca), St. Agnes (Avon),

and St. Francis Xavier.

Sister Janice will work mostly with the diocesan elementary schools, but will, she said, also involve some secondary schools into her work.

According to the Education Department job description, Sister Janice will be responsible for, among other things, "building and working with advisory curriculum committees of teachers, meeting with representatives of publishers and validating them for school visitation," and "serving as liaison with State Education Department subject specialists."
