

Give Generously The Family Rosary for Peace



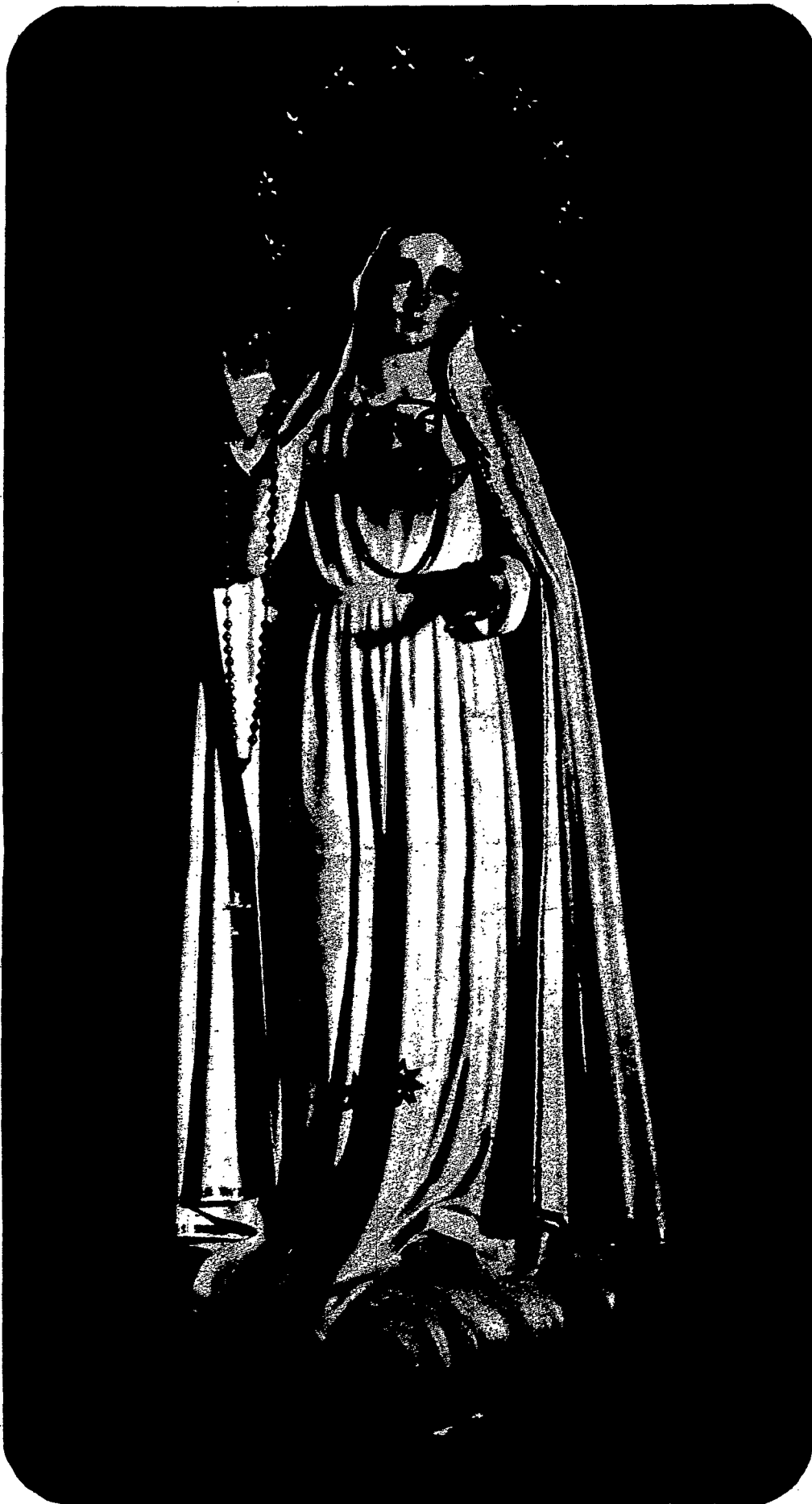
My dear Friends,

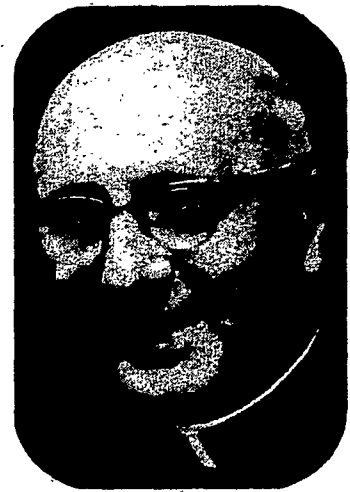
