Dr. Frisk Wins 'Oppy'

Elmira — Dr. James N. Frisk, an Elmira pediatrician and founder of Pediatric Health Care Associates of St. Joseph's Hospital, received the "Oppy" in ceremonies Oct. 19 at St. Joseph's Hospital.

A Washington, D.C., native, Dr. Frisk was cited for his personal concern for patients and family as but one of many reasons his nominator offered in nominating him to be the second 1981 recipient of the long-standing recognition for outstanding service to St. Joseph's and its community.

Sister Martha Gersbach, administrator, presented him with memorabilia including a plaque and award pin. Dr. Frisk is the first physician to win the award.

Dr. Frisk earned his medical degree at Georgetown University, interned at St. Joseph's from 1960 to 1961, and served his residency at Children's Hospital of the District of Columbia. Board certified by the American Board of Pediatrics, Dr. Frisk served in the U.S. Air Force, attaining the rank of captain.

He is a member of the Chemung County and New York State Medical Societies, and serves on the staffs of St. Joseph's and Arnot Ogdén hospitals. He served as chief of pediatrics at St. Joseph's from 1968 to 1973, and presently serves as president of the Chemung County Medical Society.

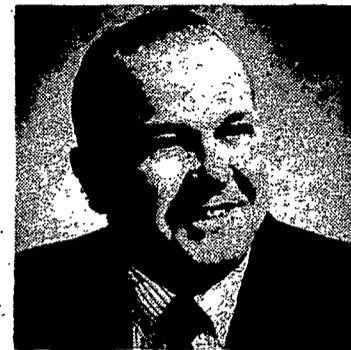
