Pray to Mary for Peace

Following is the text of recent remarks given by Pope John Paul II on Our Lady of Guadalupe.

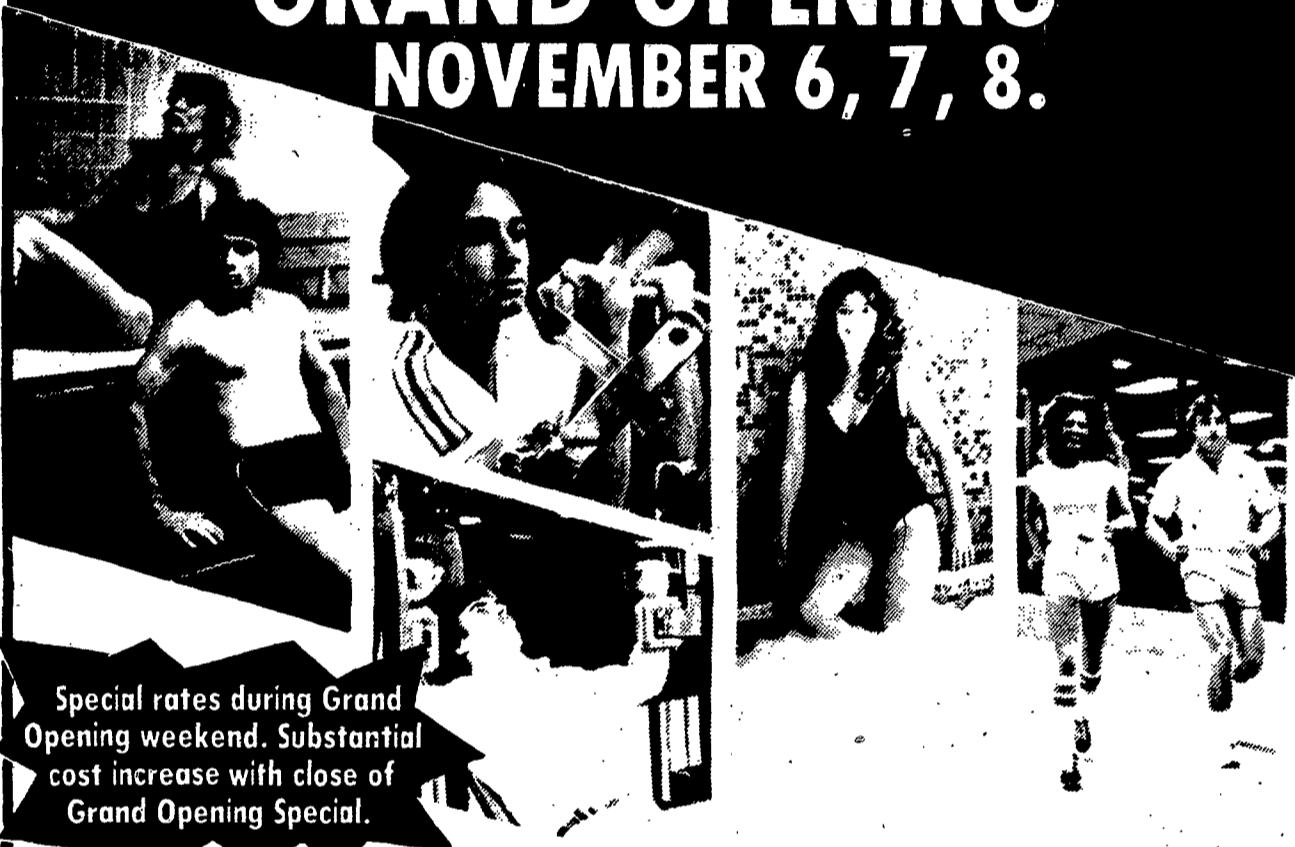
This year we celebrate the 450th anniversary of the apparition of the Mother of God at Guadalupe, in Mexico, to whose sanctuary I have had the joy of going as a pilgrim in the first months of my pontificate. I do not cease to recommend in prayer to Our Lady, who in this sanctuary is venerated as the Lady and Queen of America, and especially of Latin America, all the nations and peoples of that great continent. I do this listening to the events; sometimes disquieting, and sharing the concerns of the bishops and priests, to whom I am united in the pastoral ministry.

I wish today to invite everyone to join in this prayer.

In particular, I invite you to recommend to the Mother of God our brother and sisters often painfully tested in Salvador, praying that there may reign internal peace, so desired in the society in which some thousands of men and women (among whom there is even an archbishop) have suffered death, victims of fratricidal struggles.

In addition, the cases of killings and kidnappings of some priests in Guatemala have aroused worry and pain. Entrusting all the deceased to Divine Mercy, I join the appeal of the Guatemalan Episcopal Conference which calls for the pursuit of an internal peace, stable and secure, to guarantee freedom to the Church in her pastoral mission.
