The week will conclude

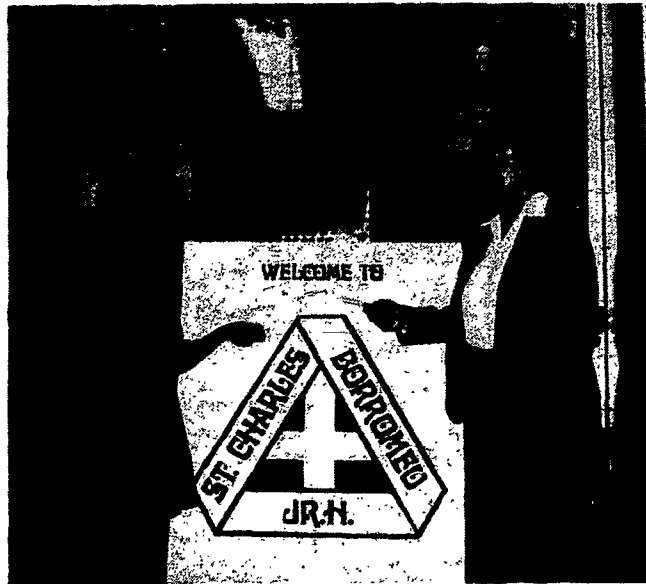
with a baked foods sale, a Christian book fair and coffee after all the Sunday Masses
