

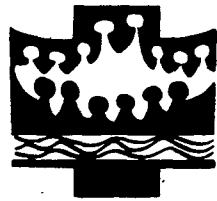


### Broadway Weekend

### Insights In Liturgy

### A Sacred Space for Reservation

What architectural feature does St. Peter's in Rome, St. Patrick's in New York, Notre Dame in Paris, and the proposed sketches for the new Assumption Church in Fairport all have in common? Each of these places of worship has a Blessed Sacrament chapel.

Of the many dimensions of the liturgical renewal of Vatican II, the recommendation to place the tabernacle in a separate chapel is the most disturbing and misunderstood. A closer look at the historical and theological context which prompted this action should clarify some misconceptions.

Until the Middle Ages, the Sacrament which remained after the eucharistic celebration was taken to the sick and dying, or simply left in a container called a pyx in a cupboard with the other things used at Mass. Later, the Sacred Bread was reserved in a dove-shaped vessel suspended from the ceiling of a side alcove or vestry. It wasn't until the post-Renaissance Age that adoration of Christ present in the reserved Sacrament became popular. The liturgical language and ritual had become complex and unintelligible to the common folk. The spectator role of the congregation called for little or no participation in the action of the eucharistic rite. Therefore, great attention became attached to the reserved presence of Christ. However, it has only been in the last 150 years that it became common to place the tabernacle on the main altar.

Today, the Church in its continuing process of growth and renewal has reached back into the past and called us to a deeper understanding of Christ's sacramental presence in the reserved Eucharist. By restoring separate Blessed

Sacrament chapels, the Church has graphically reminded us that the dynamic, active presence of the Lord in liturgy is made most significantly when distinct in space and time from the static, reserved sacramental presence in the tabernacle. Each has its own focus and time: the one as the center of our communal worship, the other as the object of our private prayer and adoration. Far from relegating the Sacrament to a place of unimportance, this arrangement provides a distinct and unique place of reverence.

From a more practical aspect, the size of each setting is determined by the number of people gathering for prayer. An intimate space for quiet prayer is provided for those who wish to visit the Blessed Sacrament during the day.

However, in creating this Blessed Sacrament chapel we must be cautious that we do not lose sight of the original and primary reason for reservation of the Eucharist: as Communion for the sick and dying and the adoration of our Lord by the faithful. To use this chapel for daily Mass, with an altar immediately in front of the tabernacle, defeats its purpose and merely transfers to a smaller setting what we are trying to avoid in the larger area.

In summary, the teaching of Vatican II and later documents of implementation state:

- there be a separate chapel for the reserved Blessed Sacrament.
- if this is not possible, the tabernacle should be placed in a suitable area distinct from the sanctuary.
- the Blessed Sacrament chapel be used primarily as a place of reservation.
- there be but one tabernacle in a church building.
- there be a lamp burning near the tabernacle.
