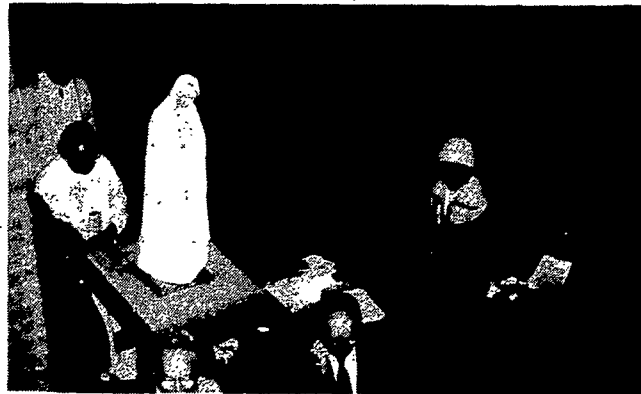
St. Philip Neri
