#### **PERSONALIZED CHRISTMAS BOOK**

### **CHRISTMAS CARD**

What probably was the first Christmas card appeared in 1843, and was designed by John Collcott Horsley.

Horsely was a fashionable strict Victorian who led a campaign against the use of nude models.

His first Christmas card was commissioned by Sir Henry Cole, and took the form of an obling sheet with three illustrations. In the center was a drawing of a middle class Victorian family at Christmas dinner.

On one side, was a depiction of a good Samaritan feeding the hungry. On the other, a drawing showed another good soul clothing the naked, though in this case the supposedly naked figure was drawn

fully clothed. Horsley presented his card to Sir Henry Cole with the in-scription: "To his good friend Cole/Who's a merry young soul/And a merry young soul is he/And may be for many # vears to come/Hooray!
