An Arthritis Teaching Day is scheduled from 2 to 5 p.m. on Tuesday, May 18, at Rochester General Hospital in the main conference room.

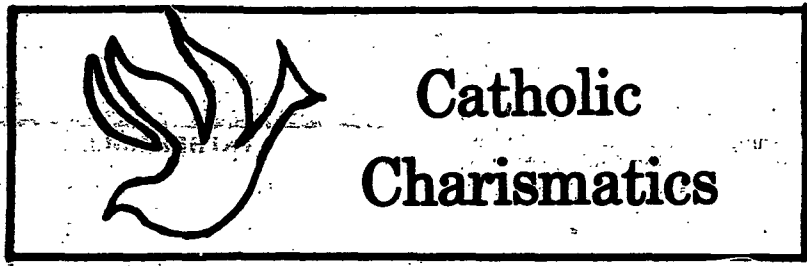
