A healing Mass is scheduled at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, June 3, at St. Patrick's Church in Mt. Morris.

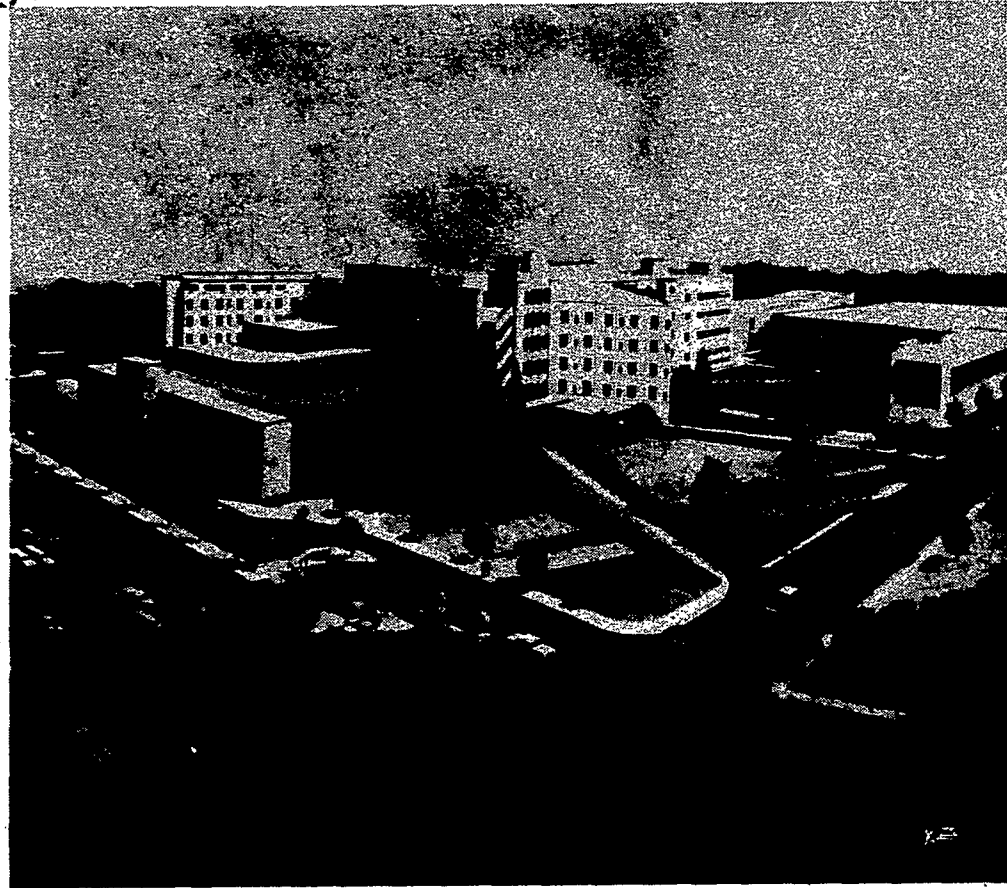
At 8 p.m. on Friday, June 4, he will celebrate the tenth anniversary Mass of the First Friday Charismatic Masses at St. Lawrence Church in

The Human Development Committee of Sacred Heart Cathedral parish has passed a resolution calling for an end to further budget cuts in social programs by the federal government.

The resolution declares that the 1982 U.S. budget "cut \$35 billion from human service programs while military spending was increased \$44 billion and ... the total proposed federal budget for fiscal year 1983 is \$750 billion, less than \$80 billion targeted specifically for the poor."

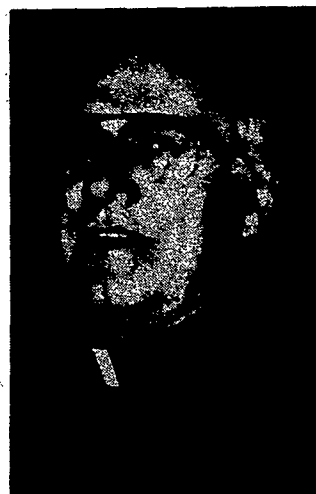
