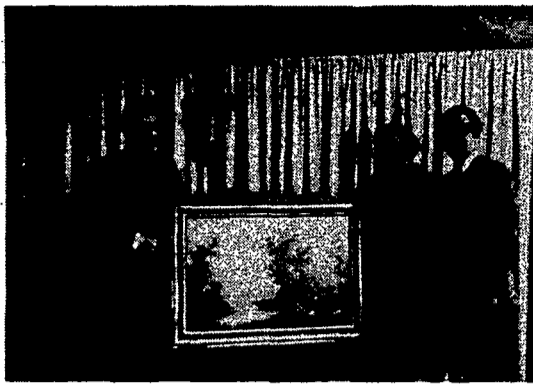


At Your Parish...
