## **Test Yourself** On Bible

Sister Marcian, School Sisters of Notre Dame, is the only teacher still at Bishop Kearney High School from when it opened 20 years ago. She taught chemistry for years. She also taught religion. Students have told me she really taught religion. This may seem a strange remark, but many students in years past in Catholic high schools have complained that in many classes they got sociology and psychology in religion classes. So when religion is taught, it is a cause for rejoicing. Sister Marcian is now retired but is busy doing clerical work in the school office. Our Holy Trinity parish, Webster, has 110 students at Kearney, 10 miles away. One student brought me a paper with 50 questions, to test oneself on "the saints." She said: "Sister Marcian made this up for us. She stirs up our religious interest," Questions were, for example: "Who received the five wounds of Jesus in his body?" "Who was converted by reading the lives of the saints and who founded the Society of Jesus?"

I decided to adapt it for my annual Christmas folder, using 20 saints instead of 50. I was surprised at the great interest the test evinced. I sent one to a student at Becket Hall. He said: "It's interesting, but I am more interested in the Bible. Why don't you make a test on Scripture?" "Good idea. You make it and I'll put it in the OTRSide column." Years ago we now older Catholics got our Old Testament knowledge from a tan colored "Bible History" by Bishop Gilmour. Today more Catholics are reading the Bible, and there are many different translations: some good, some less so.
