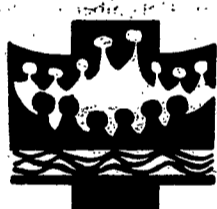

## Insights In Liturgy

## The Ordo Missae Report

Diocesan participants in the Study of the Mass have consistently called for the use of more silence in our celebrations of the Eucharist. When they studied the Liturgy of the Word, they urged the use of silence after the readings. Again, in evaluating their experience of Sunday Eucharist, they commented on the necessity of silent prayer following the distribution of Communion. They urged that this period of silence be observed even when a hymn of praise is used at this time and that this silent time be sufficiently long.

These same people have again and again remarked that the assembly needs to be encouraged to sing and respond verbally with enthusiasm. They see value to a joyful, lively recession whether that recession be song or an instrumental. But they request that announcements be brief and given only when necessary, but not within Eucharist celebration. Most participating parishes noted that these announcements should begin before the celebration begins. They see no value to purifying the chalice and ciboria at the altar after Communion and would much prefer that this

take place in the sacristy after Mass.

When I examine the vision of Eucharist that the participants have held up to my eyes, one word comes to my mind to describe this vision: rhythm. Participants in this study over the past months have called for a rhythmic flow to liturgical celebration, a flow that rises and falls, proclaims faith and silently contemplates. This vision is certainly consistent with the vision of the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy which calls for a promotion of active participation by the people in "acclamations, responses, psalms, antiphons and songs, as well as by active gesture and bodily attitudes ... and ... a reverent silence."

The Liturgy Office is extremely grateful to the parish coordinators and participants who have worked these past 10 months on this project. Parish groups who have evaluated the process have remarked again and again about the educational value this study has been for them. They acknowledged that their parish experience of Eucharist has improved because of the study and that the celebration of Eucharist has taken on new and deeper meaning for them. What more could we ask?
