The Liturgy Office is extremely grateful to the parish coordinators and participants who have worked these past 10 months on this project. Parish groups who have evaluated the process have remarked again and again about the educational value this study has been for them. They acknowledged that their parish experience of Eucharist has improved because of the study and that the celebration of Eucharist has taken on new and deeper meaning for them.
