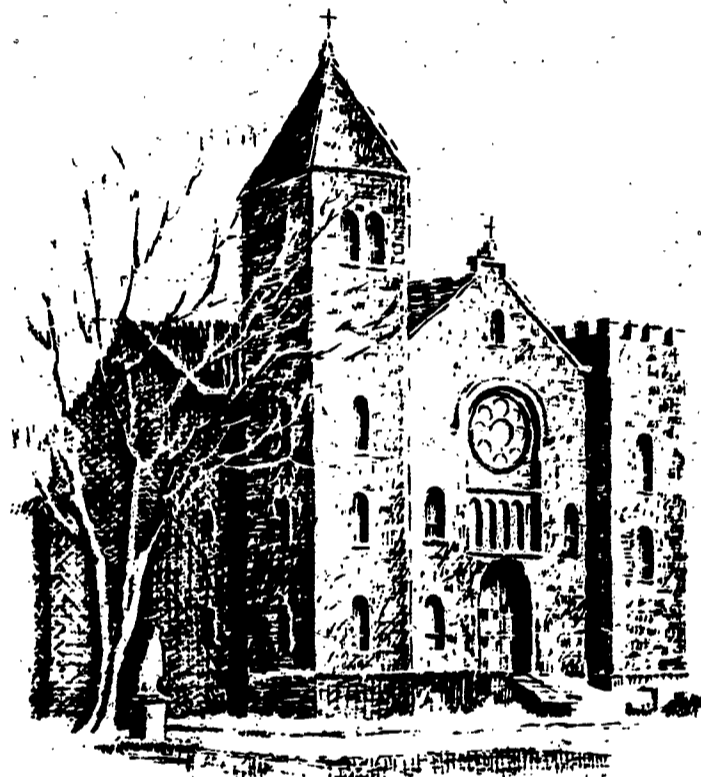


NIAGARA UNIVERSITY
