THE MAN

Lew Lehrman is the only candidate for Governor who has helped build a business, met a payroll and created thousands of jobs in the private sector. In 1981, he was named Chairman of the Cardinal Cooke Inner-City Award Dinner, which raised over \$1.5 million for these parochial schools. He has been an active supporter of Cardinal Hayes High School in the Bronx.

THE ISSUES

CRIME— Lew Lehrman: "It takes tough judges, an end to irresponsible plea bargaining, definite prison sentences, and the death penalty to make our streets safe."

JOBS AND TAXES— Lew Lehrman has a comprehensive economic renewal program for New York. • The goal of his program is 200,000 new jobs a year. • He has a tax reform plan to reduce personal income tax rates 5 percent per year for eight years, in order to make New York competitive again. • As Governor, he will campaign against any increase in property taxes on existing owners.
