Little Rock Bible Study Seen Growing

The program of Bible study started in Little Rock, Ark., eight years ago, and brought to St. Paul's Parish in Webster last September, has spread to St. Lawrence in Greece and St. Anne's on Mt. Hope Avenue.

Program spokesperson Georgette Ermatinger also noted, "Several other parishes have not firmed up their dates as yet, but seem interested enough to begin similar studies before year's end."

"St. Paul's in Webster," she said, "was the first to try it and it proved very successful in an age where adult. education is usually a disaster.'

The Little Rock program consists of several weeks of small-group discussion on particular books of the Bible. Promotional literature stated. "The study is geared to the average layman. It is not primarily a technical study of

scripture, but rather its aim isto facilitate the application of God's living word in the daily life of each person. Thus it is an opportunity for both educational and spiritual growth. It will culminate in leading the individual into a deeper understanding of self and his personal relationship with God."

The St. Paul's Parish group will study the Gospel of Mark, on Thursday evenings from Jan. 6 to March 10. Acts will be covered at St. Lawrence beginning Jan. 14, and the same book will be studied at St. Anne's beginning Jan. 19.
