Latin Mass Scheduled At Old St. Mary's

A specially scheduled Latin Mass for the first Sunday of Lent will be celebrated at 3 p.m., Feb. 20, at Old St. Mary's Church in downtown Rochester.

Celebrant will be Msgr. George Cocuzzi, director of the diocesan Permanent Diaconate Program and pastor of St. Francis Xavier Church.

Traditional Gregorian chants will be sung by a group of Eastman School of Music students under the direction of Prof. Hendrik van der Werf. Except for the readings, the liturgy will be celebrated entirely in Latin but a Mass

booklet will be provided giving pertinent translations and congregational chants.

The use of Gregorian chant, so long a part of the Roman Catholic heritage, has drastically declined since the change from Latin to the vernacular in recent years. In some Catholic circles, however, there has been interest in a re-evaluation of this traditional music. As a reflection, Catholic University has scheduled an international symposium in June with participants from a dozen countries and with the purpose of exploring the resource of Gregorian chant to enhance the prayer life of the Church for centuries.

The Feb. 20 liturgy will be a rare opportunity for Rochesterians to experience this liturgical music.

The group will be limited to six couples and cost of the

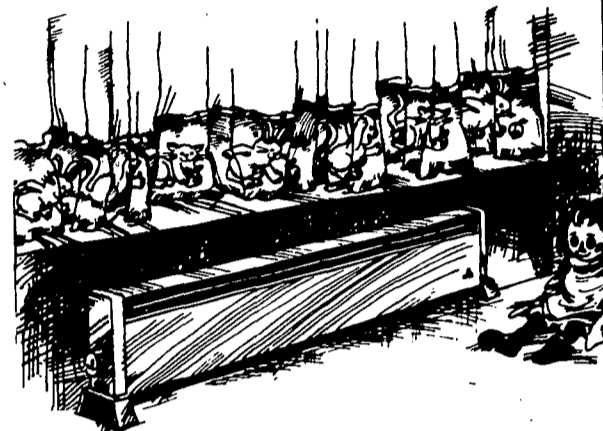
