Macedon Parish Launches Centennial with Dance

St. Patrick Church, Macedon, will mark 100 years of service to the diocese this year with a variety of activities, beginning with a dance at 9 p.m. on Saturday, March 12, in the parish hall.

Among other activities scheduled to mark the centennial anniversary are: Bishop's Mass followed by a banquet at Marvin's Country Club on May 1; Mother's Day Mass, May 8; Knights of Columbus and Ladies Guild Mass, family picnic at Samuel's Park in the afternoon, May 15; Francis Murray Mass for all deceased parishioners and pastors,

The parish was formed in May 1883 under the direction of Father Michael A. F. Holmes, who remained as pastor until 1929. The current pastor is Father Eugene McFarland, who will celebrate his 40th anniversary to the priesthood this year.

Training sessions for Rochester Interfaith Jail Ministry volunteers have been slated 7-9:30 p.m., Monday, March 14, Wednesday, March 16, and Monday, March 21, at Downtown Presbyterian Church, 121 North Fitzhugh St.

Volunteers visit with prisoners in the Monroe County Jail on a one-to-one basis, serving as friends and advocates and assisting them in meeting basic human needs.

The training program includes information about the Rochester Interfaith Jail Ministry program, the jail, the courts and an opportunity to role-play jail visiting experiences. Prospective volunteers must attend all three evenings of the training.

There is a particular need for volunteers who speak Spanish or Asian languages.
