

Dennis R. Sewar to Be Ordained

Bishop Matthew H. Clark will ordain Rev. Mr. Dennis R. Sewar to the priesthood, 11 a.m., Saturday, April 23, at St. Pius Tenth Church in Chili.

The ordinand is the 31-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Sewar, parishioners at the Church of the Good Shepherd in Henrietta.

A native of Brooklyn, the future priest moved to the Rochester area with his family at the age of 11. He graduated from James E. Sperry High School in 1969, a member of that school's first graduating class. He pursued his studies at SUNY Brockport, where he earned a BS in English and elementary school teacher certification in 1973.

He taught at Good Shepherd for four years, during which time he also did freelance disk jockey work, and served as playground

director during the summers at the Vollmer School.

He entered Becket Hall in 1977, and St. Bernard's Seminary in the year following. He completed his fourth year of theology

studies at Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C.

His field education assignments have been to St. Joseph's in Rush, Lourdes Camp (a facility in the Diocese of Syracuse), St. Patrick's in Elmira, the Rochester Psychiatric Center, and St. Joseph's in Alexandria, Va.

He took Clinical Pastoral Education at Hawaii State Hospital in 1981, and last year taught briefly at Sacred Heart Cathedral School while awaiting assignment as deacon intern at St. Pius Tenth.

The ordination Mass theme will be from the Gospel of Luke, "Be compassionate as your Father is compassionate."

Father Sewar's first Mass of thanksgiving will be celebrated 12:15 p.m.,

Sunday, April 24, at Good Shepherd. Father Gerald Connor, pastor at St. Pius, will preach. A second Mass of thanksgiving is planned for 5 p.m., Saturday, April 30, at St. Pius.

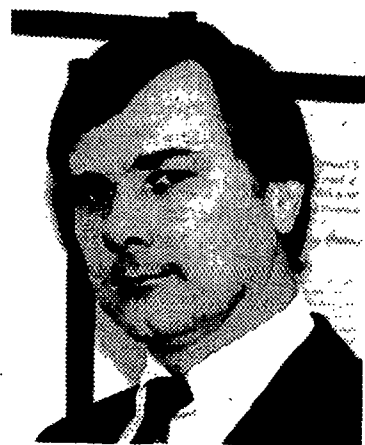
