# 700 OLPH Alumni Gather this Week

An extraordinary response to invitations to the first alumni reunion of Our Lady of Perpetual Help school was reported last week.

According to Sister Clare Francis Mogenhan, principal of the school, more than 700 reservations have been made for the event April 23 at the Mapledale Party House.

The Sister of St. Joseph also

noted that alumni will return to Rochester from as far away as California for the event.

The parish will be 80 years old next April. The school was once a part of the church building. At the time of the laying of the original cornerstone, Bishop Bernard J. McQuaid commented: "This lower floor will be for the church proper; the upper one for the school. The Church

has not divorced education from religion... While the sacred practices are carried on in the church below, the blessed work of instructing in the same holy things will go on in the rooms above."

A second church was erected about a generation later, and the old church was completely remodeled into school quarters.
