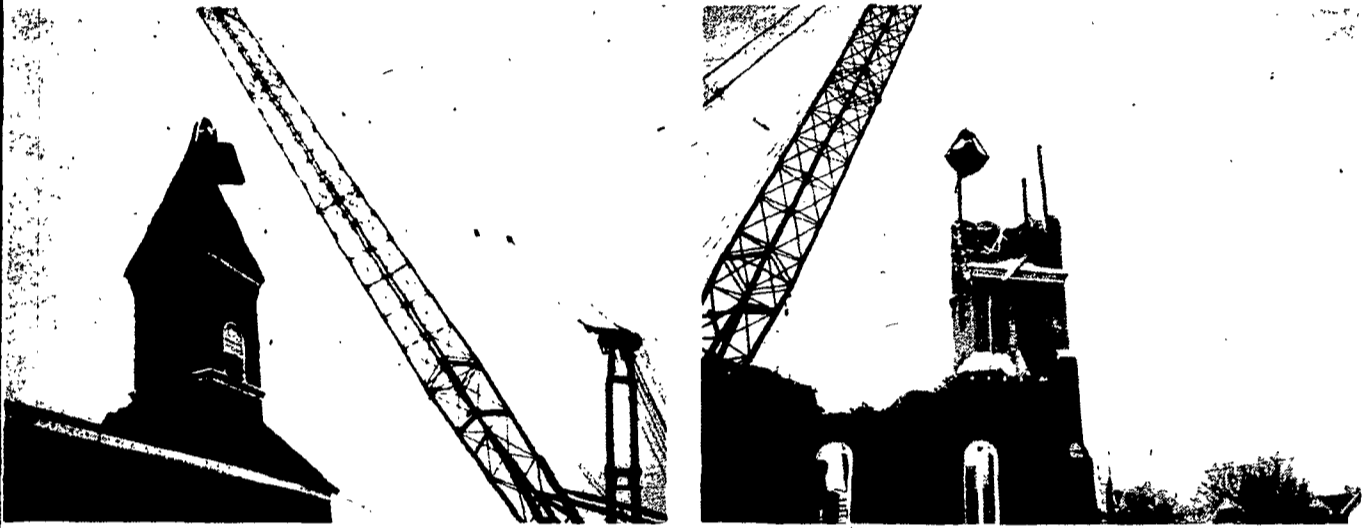


Church Demolished

Demolition of the 100-year-old church at Assumption Parish, Fairport, took place Tuesday through Friday, April 5-8. The cornerstone dated 1882 was opened that Friday. Inside were found copies of the Fairport Herald dated Sept. 5, 1882, and the Rochester Union and Advertiser dated Sept. 6, 1882, along with numerous coins — one dating back to 1866. Assumption Parish opened its new church on March 12.
