Recently, Father Charles Latus, chief of our diocesan personnel board, phoned: "Father Gene Weis of Palmyra needs a supply, just for Saturday and Sunday, April 9 and 10. Could you take care of it?" "Yes. Glad to," So I phoned Father Weis to get directions. With his customary effervescence, he exclaimed, "Wonderful! We are not Catholics, but Catholic friends invited us. I think it was one of the most wonderful events of my life." With such an incident in memory, I was doubly glad to spell Father Weis who is active in both ME and Cursillo.

Saturday, April 9, I landed at the rectory. Pastoral assistant Sister Kathy McCarthy, SSJ, was there to guide me properly. There was a special: a baptism at the Saturday night Mass. A note from Mary Rutkowski, parish secretary, was on the kitchen counter: "If I can be of assistance, phone me at home," adding the telephone number. Confessions were light. So before the 5 p.m. Mass Sister Kathy gave me the baptismal booklet they use, and each member of the congregation had a copy to follow the rite.

Rare experiences often exhilarate me, so before proclaimed: have a baptism during Mass. Good liturgy should flow smoothly and with spirit. So let's put our souls into this Mass and baptism." And everyone did, gloriously. I was in high gear. The altar boys were alert. The Sunday Masses at , Palmyra (8, 9:15, and 11 a.m.) manifested a strong faith and devotion. When all was finished I had dinner with Dan DeVito, his two children and his Japanese wife, Yoko, whom I baptized in Clyde around 20 years ago. Having been to Japan last October, I wondered: "Will Yoko serve a special Japanese dinner?" It turned out to be ravioli, nicely spiced meat balls, hot garlic bread, salad and desert. I left Palmyra humming happily.
