'Words Not Enough'

Boise, Idaho — "Words alone are not enough" when it comes to promoting the equality of women in the Church, Bishop Sylvester Treinen of Boise said in a pastoral letter on women's issues. In fact, he added, "rather than discriminate unfairly, Church leaders should actively promote and welcome approved roles for women everywhere in the Church." The letter, "An Elusive Search," noted that the exclusion of women from the priesthood poses a major problem for many women and some men. But he offered no direct opinions on the issue, saying that the discussion is likely to continue.

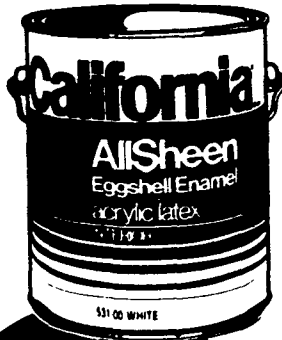

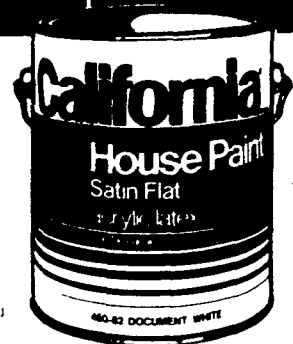
