Revisiting Ireland

From Sister M. Vianney, Sligo, Ireland:

"I do hope and pray you will enjoy every moment of your May tour, and nobody is to get a heart attack this year! D.V. and I hope the gentleman who was taken ill last year is well and strong again. I am looking forward to meeting you in Limerick or Ennis. I was sorry to read this is possibly your last visit to Ireland. How come? We will sort that one out when we meet.

So you met Sister Marianne O'Connor at Cornell University, Ithaca. She has a brother missionary priest out there, too. She is a fine person. I expect she will be home for the summer holidays and ready to take over the onerous task of principal of our Home Economics College at St. Angela's.

"I must cry 'halt' now. God bless you, Father, and looking forward to seeing you. Hope the old tin lizzy doesn't let me down. It's 10 years old now, and one of the surgeons says: 'Here comes Vianney in her little transistor.'"

COMMENT: In May, 1974, our tour group stayed overnight in Sligo. The next morning was the First Friday. I wondered, "Is the First Friday devotion still strong in Ireland?" So I scooped up the steep hill to the Cathedral. The church was well filled. There I met Sister Vianney, one of 50 nuns connected with the Ursuline college in Sligo. I gave her a set of Sheen cassette conferences, and began a pen pal correspondence. Sister Vianney does social work among the poor, the elderly and alcoholics, so I have added to her cassette library. She wrote: "Ah, Father, Archbishop Sheen's talks are grand for our poor household people." And she sent one to their Sisters in Africa.

The "gentleman who got sick" was Emmett Hennessy of Mother of Sorrows, Rochester. He had a heart attack at midnight at the Great Southern Hotel in Killarney and was hospi-

talized for a month in Tralee in a 62-bed hospital which has 22 Sisters. He recovered so well he is returning with us this very tour.

Irish letters carry curious abbreviations, e.g. "D.V." is Deo Volente (God Willing), and "T.G." is thanks to God, stuck in the middle or end of a declarative sentence. To get the flavor and strange intertwining of faith, reverence, inconsistencies and irreverences do read Frank O'Connor's short stories. These narrations with their twists and turnings are fun to read. And they help us to understand, if possible, the Irish mentality.

From a collegian:

"I am a college student at the University of X, and returned home last summer. My sister, also in college, had purchased a booklet. I went to St. Ann's book rack to buy one for myself, and there were none left. I contacted Mrs. Andrew Lamb who referred me to you.

"I don't have the title, but it is light blue, three by five size, with a picture of the Madonna and Child. Inside are many prayers a Christian should have in order to better align oneself to God, such as the Creed, Act of Contrition, Beatitudes, Prayer to St. Michael.

"The booklet has brought us to a greater interest to leading more Christian lives, especially in college. Is it possible to get a copy?" COMMENT: The 32-page booklet, "Treasury of Prayers," I have peddled and sold over 6,000 copies — which is like planting 6,000 fruit trees continuing to bear fruit. The bishop of Pittsburgh some years ago ordered 60,000 copies: one for each child in Catholic grade and high schools, and in the CCD program.

Last March, a lady stopped me in Rochester General Hospital and said, "You do not know me, but I bought five copies of the 'Treasury of Prayers,' and gave one to my husband. He loved it so much he prayed from it every day. He died a month ago, and he prayed from the booklet the very day he died."
