

1983 has been announced by His Holiness Pope John Paul II to be a special Holy Year, in commemoration of the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ which occurred one thousand, nine-hundred and fifty years ago. The celebrations of the Holy Year commenced on February 16, 1983, the first day of Lent.

During a Holy Year the pope grants to the faithful, under particular circumstances, Plenary Indulgence, or general forgiveness.

On the occasion of the Holy Year 1750, Pope Benefict XIV laid down the requirements necessary to be granted a Plenary Indulgence. They consist of (1) a visit to the four major Basilicas of Rome — St. Peter's, St. Paul's, St. John Lateran, and St. Mary Major; (2) the sacraments of Confession and Communion; and (3) special prayers for the intentions of the

Although Holy Year has its roots in ancient tradition, it is profoundly relevant to us today . . it aims at nothing less than the spiritual renewal of man. The pilgrim who visits the Eternal city lives firsthand the glory, traditions, and faith of the Church. Here the pilgrim witnesses the unity of the Church as men and women of every race, culture, and nation bear witness to their faith in a Gospel of love, justice, and peace!
