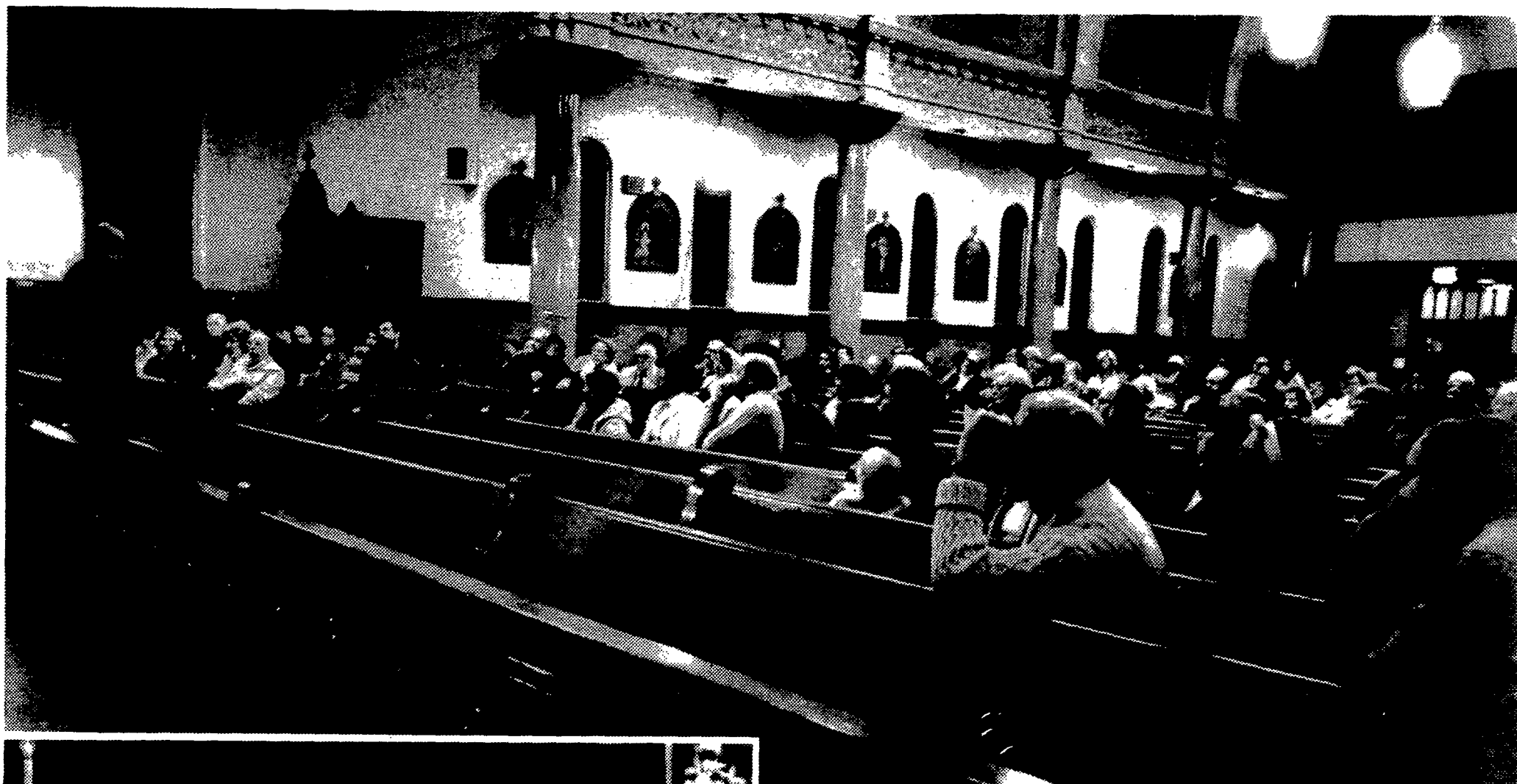


Varieties of Vigils
