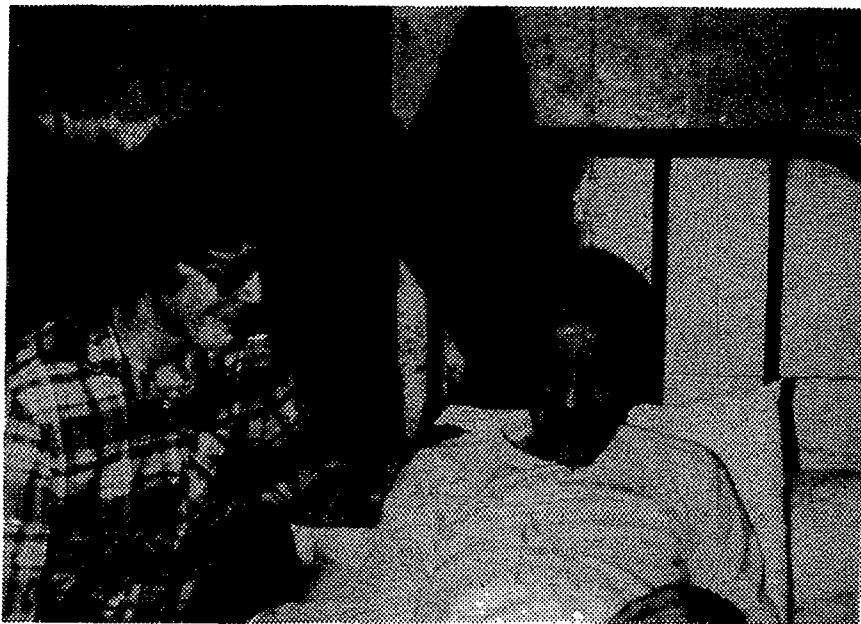




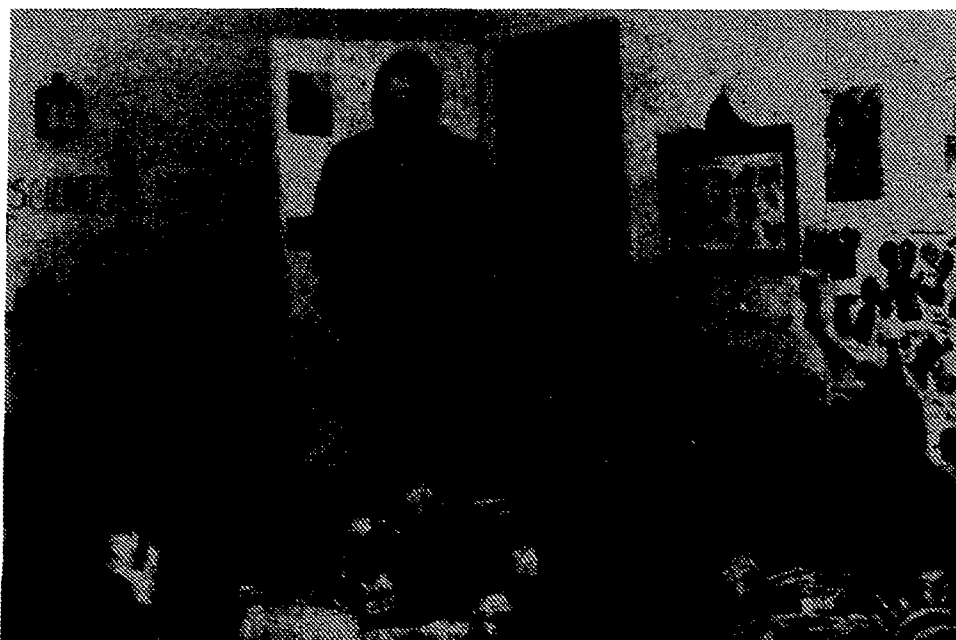

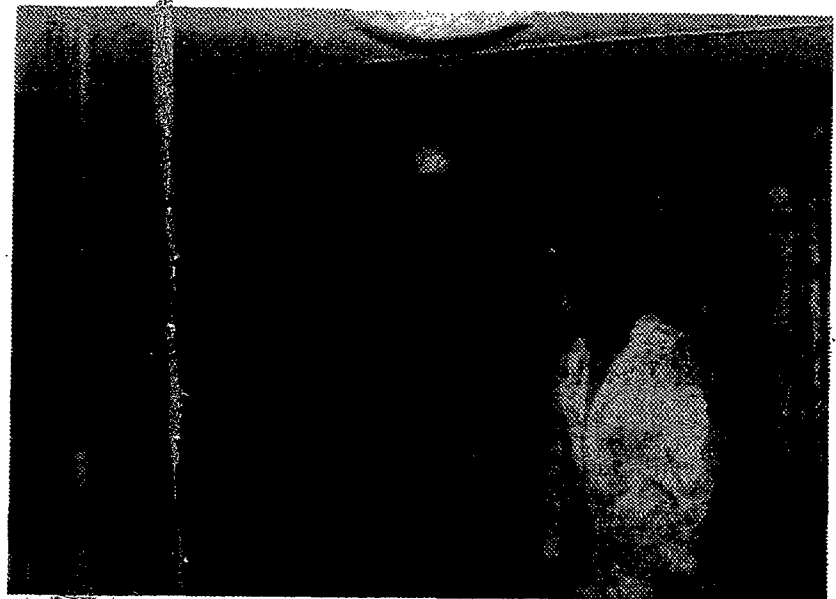
The readings for the Easter Season remind us of the early Church: "the community of believers were of one mind and heart."
