PAA Elects New Officers

The Pastoral Assistants with diocesan policy and Association, PAA, has elected new officers for 1984-85: Sister Diane Branch SSJ, president; Sister Lisette O'Brien RSM, treasurer; Sister Judy Morgan RSM, secretary; and Sister Anne Michelle McGill SSJ, Pastoral Assistants Committee (PAC) representative.

PAA is a professional support group concerned with the spiritual and educational enrichment of its members. It serves as a vehicle for communication between its members, parishes and other diocesan ministries. Its members include all pastoral ministers in the diocese, said Sister Nancy DeRycke SSJ, spokesperson for the organization.

According to Sister Elizabeth Hughes RSM, PAC, on the other hand, "represents the pastoral assistants at the diocesan level, establishing policy for pastoral assistants, facilitating the certification and hiring of pastoral assistants, implementing and amending the guidelines in accordance with diocesan practices. The committee is accountable to the Division of Personnel, directed by Father Charles Latus. Father Latus is chairman of the committee." Sister Elizabeth said that about 61 parishes in the diocese use the ministry of the pastoral assistant.

The next meeting of the PAA will be 9:30 a.m.-noon, Nov. 14 at the motherhouse of the Sisters of St. Joseph. Sister Molly Brown RSM, widely known as a psychologist and counselor in the area, will speak at the event.

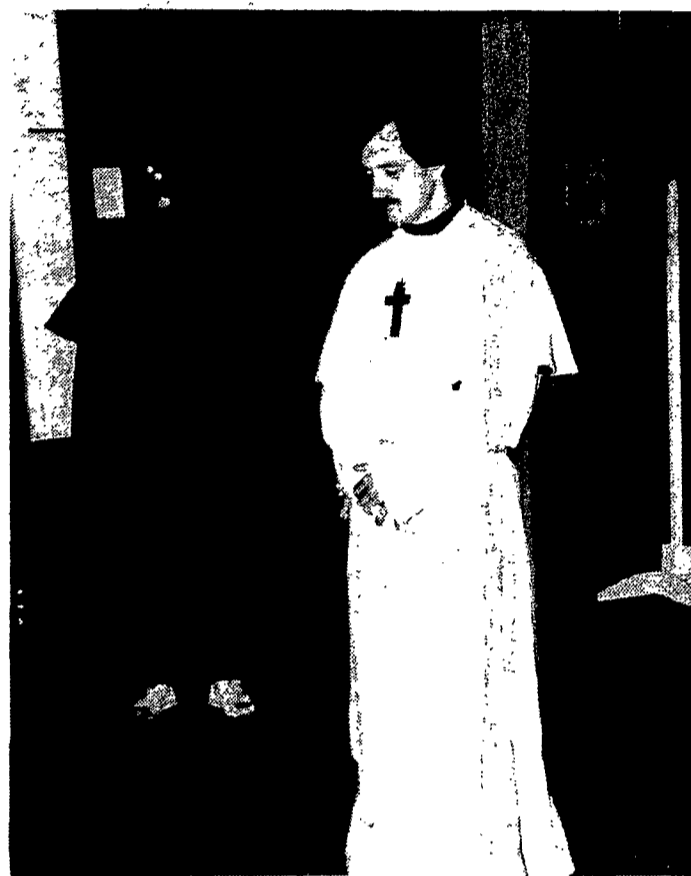
