FLOSM Offers Retreat Days To Unemployed

Geneva — The Finger Lakes Office of Social Ministry will offer a two-day retreat for the unemployed with the theme, "To leave the past, allows me to enter the future," 9:30 a.m., Tuesday, Oct. 23 to 4 p.m., Wednesday, Oct. 24 at High Acres Conference Center on Snell Road.

A FLOSM release defines the unemployed as including "discouraged workers (persons who have run out of unemployment benefits), displaced homemakers (women who because of divorce or death of a spouse must return to the job market) and persons who are currently unemployed."

The event is free. The FLOSM release stated: "The retreat will offer an opportunity for sharing, and an environment of nurturing, a breathing space. The two days will allow time for letting go for those who have been 'let go.' "It will be a real change of pace, a chance to get away for two days and gain a new perspective on what is going through the inner person due to unemployment."

"The time together will provide an opportunity to share frustrations and concerns with others who face a similar problem. This time apart will help to discover ways of coping as well as explore creative uses of time."

FLOSM also said that "the retreat is designed to offer

insights to unemployed persons to better understand how to work and live through this critical life change.

Coordinating the event are Mrs. Anne Schaezke, senior at Empire State College; Deacon Victor Yanaitis; Thomas McKellop, assistant director of Job Search Unlimited; Carl Ritz, program developer for FLOSM and Ted Bartot, a member of the FLOSM board.
