According to Father Winfried Kellner, Catholic chaplain at the hospital, the parish council members are a representative body of Catholic patients at MCH. Their goal is promoting the good of the Catholic community at the hospital and tying in with other parish councils in the diocese. "No one is poor," he said, "if he is willing to help those less fortunate than he. This is the lesson of the Widow's Mite, a lesson which seems most appropriate at this time of year." The residents gave \$50 and a turkey to each of six area agencies: St. Martin's Place, Bethany House, Melita House, St. Joseph's House of Hospitality, the Salvation Army and the Open Door Mission. In addition, they sent two cases of soup and 21 pounds of coffee to Blessed Sacrament Church, which runs overnight shelter for up to 15 people.
